Health update

Grace and I are back from Nairobi (Kenya) where had gone for my health follow up (July 28 – Aug 2). It was very encouraging to notice the great improvement, with a stronger heart within a considerable recovery. A number of tests were carried out and all results point towards normalcy of my bodily systems. For this we are more than grateful to God, now in a heightened spiritual inquiry with resolve to complete the task that Jesus our Lord has handed to us.

Thus, my medicine intake was reduced from five to two types, with promising implications on our budget. It has been so costly for us to sustain the availability of my needed drugs. Because of the adjustment made in my medicine intake, I am expected to return to Nairobi for assessment sooner than usual. So we hope to go back in January 2026. We can clearly see how God has responded to the many prayers, the encouragement, utilization of financial support and concern of people such as you, for His wider and eternal purposes in my life. *Please join your hearts with ours in thanking God for thus far; with his healing hand on my life, and for surrounding us with such a great support through you, beloved in Christ.*

The African Missions Conference

All this, that the Lord reveals about how He restores us, is meant to drive us on our knees in thanksgiving, and a refreshed inquiry about serving Him. And as we think of the PT ministry uplift, an opportunity to gather again with like-minded Gospel workers is organised to take place in Nairobi from Sept 23 to 27, 2025. This African Missions Conference is organized by the African Mission Association, which we founded to unite evangelical efforts in global outreach.



During this conference, Perspectives Study Program will be prominent, as key in “mobilization through training”. And it is through this mobilization that the PT Institute will be populated with students, teachers, revived partners, revisited links. *Please join us to pray for the needed financial resources to facilitate four of us from Uganda to participate in this conference.*

We consider this as determinant in re-plugging our Gospel effort in Uganda, into wider partnerships and collaborations for the needed Gospel thrust. Thank you so much.

Abigail's next phase

Our daughter Abigail was able to face the US Visa interviewers two days ago, and the vetting process remains ongoing as the US Embassy retained her passport. They have not yet made a final decision regarding her application.

She says that the interview went well, with the Consular Officer only asking a few questions and not prodding so much. They will contact her within 30 days to confirm their final decision. We believe they would like to search and vet her social media before they make a final decision. It is their new policy regarding all applicants.

Please pray that Abigail will secure a student visa in time, so that she may be able to travel and commence the school year with other freshmen. And indeed, may God permit within the next two weeks, since school begins on August 23. Thank you so much.
